

## Catarrh

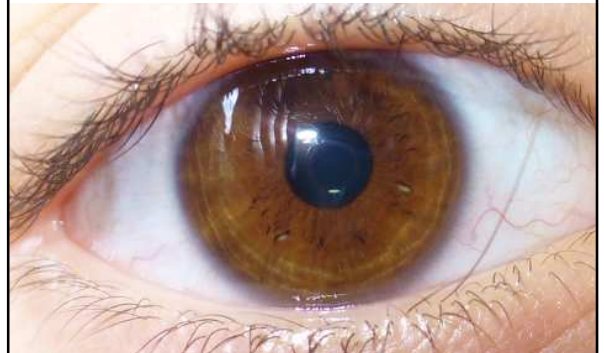
Noun - k-'tär - Greek from *katarrhein* to flow down, from *kata-* + *rhein* to flow

Catarrh is mucus which is often accompanied by acid and cell debris

Catarrh is one way the body washes the tissues and tubes of the body. It only becomes a problem when it thickens (no longer flowing) and become stagnant in the body's tissue.

This stagnation leads to parasites, virus and bacterial infestations as well as inflammation.

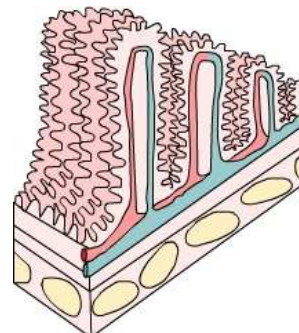
